5 AREAS OF PARTNERSHIP

SUNDAY SERVICES

Our Sunday services are a wonderful opportunity to meet together to passionately worship God and celebrate all that He is doing in our Church, our lives, and the lives of others. We thank God for His active involvement in our lives and, through His word, are encouraged and built up to go out and live every day for Him. In 2022 Alive Church's 7 locations had an average of 797 people attending weekly Sunday services. On average the total weekly Sunday attendance per month for the whole Church was 3474.

THE AVERAGE WEEKLY SUNDAY SERVICE ATTENDANCE FOR EACH LOCATION IS:

In 2022 across the Church we had 248 new people, 26 baptisms and 27 dedications.

LIFE GROUPS

Life Groups are an opportunity to meet new people, be supported and discipled in following Jesus. They are a place for discussion and application of biblical principles to our lives, changing and transforming the way we live. Across Alive Church we currently run over 50 life groups.

SERVING

Jesus is called the Servant King as He came to serve others rather than be served Himself. If we are to be more like Jesus, acts of service should be part of our life. Serving with others on a team helps us connect to the church and gives opportunities to learn, grow and meet new people.

GIVING

Giving of our finances to God is a biblical principle that predates any covenant with God, that is, it is a life principle and not an old or New Testament principle.

Acts 4:32-37 highlights that the first believers shared all they had and that in doing so no-one among them had any need. The money was brought to the Apostles to be shared out. Barnabas sells his field to give to the Apostles for them to use in helping others.

Paul's comments on the riches of God's love for us and for him becoming 'rich' in God is a state of internal change and blessing not necessarily an external one.

2 Corinthians 6:10 says

'...AS SORROWFUL, YET ALWAYS
REJOICING; AS POOR, YET MAKING
MANY RICH; AS HAVING NOTHING, YET
POSSESSING EVERYTHING'.

In 2022 the Lead Team decided to extend the financial year end by 6 months therefore creating an 18 month set of accounts.

The decision to change the year end was made to bring our accounting in line with the operations of Alive Church, which generally run from January to December. Operating the finances this way will assist with setting budgets alongside the annual vision for the Church.






