#### Gainsborough

Continued lease for another year on the Alive Offices and Hub. This has been an incredible asset to the location as we run all our groups and activities during the week and weekends in this facility. It is centrally located and provides us with a visible presence in the town.

### GENERAL BUILDING MAINTENANCE AND WORK

The quinquennial inspection was completed by Simons Design. They provided a 96 page document outlining everything that needs to be maintained and repaired.

- The roof over the office area was fully repaired where we had a significant leak.
- The internal damage to the office ceiling was fully repaired.
- The office was repainted and redecorated.
- Additional power sockets were installed in the office
- Office lighting was upgraded to LED.
- Repairs to the stonework have just been completed on the section of the building facing Avenue Road. This was done as an emergency repair as stonework was dislodged and fell out, posing a safety issue to pedestrians. Daniel Christie

prepared the architect's brief for this and the work was carried out by Lang Associates. They also re-pointed some areas on the nave and repaired some roof tiles to prevent further damage to the inside of the building.

- Flood lighting in the main auditorium was replaced.
- Fire risk assessment was completed.
- The damage caused by the attempted lightning rod theft is currently being repaired and the scaffold is still up.
- Damaged lead flashing on one section of the roof was repaired per advice from the builder and consultation with Daniel Christie.
